8 Statements that will help you have "A BFM":

Statement #7: "A Biblical Financial Mindset Pays Careful Attention to Ethics."

1. Biblical ethics teaches you how to earn money.

"Dishonest money dwindles away, but he who gathers money little by little makes it grow." (Prov.13:11)

- a. It is biblical to earn money through work. (II Thess.3:10)
- b. It is biblical to earn money through saving and investing. (Prov.21:20; 27:23-27)
- c. It is biblical to earn money through gifts. (Phil.4:18)

2. Biblical ethics teaches you how to treat others in financial dealings. (James 5:1-6)

"Differing weights and differing measures – the Lord detests them both." (Prov. 20:10)

3. Biblical ethics teaches you that your witness is more important than your wallet.

"A good name is more desirable than great riches; to be esteemed is better than silver or gold." (Prov.22:1)
